

HOW TO BECOME A NEW AYSO REFEREE

All referees need to complete an AYSO training course which covers the Laws of the Game, the way AYSO soccer games are structured (from opening coin-toss to closing handshakes), and the spirit and philosophy of AYSO. The introductory clinics are designed to be quick, easy, and fun to take - even for those with no prior soccer experience at all.

This process takes three easy steps.

1. Fill out a volunteer application form online at www.eayso.org.

When you are at the eAYSO website, click on the "First Time" button and follow the instructions on the subsequent pages to become an "AYSO VOLUNTEER". When asked, you are in **AYSO Section 1, Area P, Region 1031 (South Los Angeles)**.

Be sure to PRINT and sign two copies of your Volunteer Form at the end of your registration process. Submit the forms to your Region 1031 Referee Administrator. Scanned signed forms can be emailed to rra@ayso1031.org. You can also bring the forms to the field during the registration period or simply contact the referee administrator for information on how to submit the forms.

2. Take the online Safe Haven Course (approx 20 - 30 mins).

All AYSO volunteers need only complete the Safe Haven Course once in their AYSO career. Once your application is submitted, you will get an AYSO ID to access the Safe Haven online training. The site can be access at [AYSO Training](#). Enter your ID and select "Safe Haven for Referee" Course.

Once you've completed the course, print your certificate.

3. Register to a Regional Referee Class.
